

On November, 5, 2019, the session of the Presidential Council for the Russian Language was held.

V.V. Putin announced the new aim of the Russian Federation – forming “active and cohesive language policy which will help to keep and develop Russian language and literature in Russia and abroad”. It is supposed that laws on state language and languages of peoples of Russia will be reconsidered, standards of modern Russian language will be finalized, and these standards will become compulsory for Russian language speakers in all communication spheres.
